Quality is sealed with a dependable screw cap, designed to preserve freshness and youthful appeal. Arrogant Frog delivers exceptional quality for the price and is confident of its ability to impress!

Over the centuries, generations of the Mas family have tended the vineyards and made wine in the Languedoc. Vines were first planted here under the ancient Greeks, more than 500 years B.C.

55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot. 45% barrel aged for six months.
