In 1850, the Cinzano family – already renowned for their production of outstanding Vermouth – was tapped by the Savoy monarchs to create a sparkling wine emulating the popular French Champagne. As a result, Cinzano Sparkling Wines were born. The range includes Asti, Prosecco, Rose and Brachetto d'Acqui. Asti is today one of Italy's most popular sparkling wines.

In 2007, CINZANO celebrated its 250 anniversary and launched a website (www.cinzano.com) featuring a retrospective and iconographic journey through the most important moments of 250 years of Cinzano history.

Cinzano Sparkling Wines

CINZANO ASTI D.O.C.G.:

Produced from white Moscato grapes from the D.O.C.G. area of Asti, in the heart of Piedmont. Delicate and fruit-filled flavors pair well with desserts or as an aperitif.

CINZANO PROSECCO:

Produced from 100% Prosecco grapes in the Veneto region. Enticing aromas of apple and peach lead into a vivacious effervescence and subtle but persistent finish.

CINZANO ROSÉ:

This is a dry sparkling wine with fresh aromas of delicate wild berries. Enjoy as an aperitif or as an accompaniment to light appetizers and salads.

CINZANO BRACHETTO D'ACQUI D.O.C.G.:

An aromatic sparkling wine with sweet, fruit flavors and a distinctive ruby color. It is produced from 100% Brachetto grapes in the D.O.C.G. area of Acqui Terme and Nizza Monferrato. Delicious as an after-dinner wine or with chocolate desserts and pastries.
