Established in 1997, the approach is simple: the best regions, the best varieties. Tempus Two pays homage to classic Australian varietals and styles such as Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Shiraz and Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre by growing vines in unique regions throughout Australia.

Tempus Two benefits from 140 years of Australian viticulture mastery from the McGuigan family, who has been working vines in Australia's Hunter Valley since 1880. Today, McGuigan Wines is a force in the international wine world, recently crowned International Winemaker of the Year at the 2016 International Wine & Spirits Competition (IWSC) in London for an unprecedented fourth time!

Tempus Two has ultimate diversity in its vineyards, sourcing fruit from renowned regions like Hunter Valley, Barossa Valley, Langhorne Creek and the Adelaide Hills to craft varietal-driven wines with both substance and style. Our unique, award-winning cellar door is in the heart of the beautiful Hunter Valley.

Tempus Two was originally called 'Hermitage Road' after the road on which the original winery was located. With the name 'Hermitage' having protected status in France, the name was changed to Tempus Two, Latin for 'second time'.

- **VARIETAL SAUVIGNON BLANC (SOUTH AUSTRALIA):** A crisp refreshing style with luscious gooseberry and tropical fruit aromas and flavors. Palate has herbaceous notes and a citrus twist.
- **VARIETAL SHIRAZ (SOUTH AUSTRALIA):** Aromas of cinnamon and spice mingle with red fruits, leather and blackberries. Complex palate dominated by rich plum and spice with vanilla, licorice and blackberry jam flavors.
- **COPPER WILDE CHARDONNAY (HUNTER VALLEY, ADELAIDE HILLS):** Burgundian-style Chardonnay with rose petal aromas and a vibrant stone fruit palate.
- **COPPER SHIRAZ (LANGHORNE CREEK):** Shiraz grapes are co-fermented with Viognier to ensure maximum extraction of floral notes from the grape skins.
- **COPPER GRENACHE SHIRAZ MOURVEDRE (BAROSSA VALLEY):** Aromas of ripe red berries & plums. Medium-to-full-bodied wine with fine tannins and red berries, chocolate and coffee flavors.
