DESCRIPTION

The Loire Valley has often been called the garden of France. This pastoral landscape, with its gently rolling hills and majestic chateaux, is the largest sparkling wine region in France, outside of Champagne. One of the best known names in fine Loire Valley sparkling wines is Marquis de la Tour from Maison Ackerman. Maison Ackerman, which has been identified with premium quality Loire Valley sparkling wines since 1811, is the Loire Valleys single largest wine producer. Ackerman today has a full fledged sustainable development approach based on maintaining the right balance between the social, economic and environmental aspects of wine production. At Ackerman, this means respecting terroirs, holding onto their personal values, and pursuing a viable economic approach. Named for a 16th century tower (tour) which still exists today, Marquis de la Tour reflects a long heritage of sparkling wine production. It has been a welcome guest and the toast of the party at social gatherings and family celebrations, both formal and casual. Its stylish packaging projects a timeless, classic elegance and is a charming and affordably priced sparkling wine.

VINIFICATION

Due to the Loire Valley's northern location, the grapes maintain a high level of acidity during harvest. The grapes undergo cool stainless steel fermentation for 8 to 15 days. Consistency and quality are carefully monitored to create fine bubbles.

COLOR

Pale lemon

NOSE

Citrus and floral notes

PALATE

Slightly sweet with fine bubbles, rounded out by notes of citrus and stone fruit.

ANALYSIS

Alcohol: 11% RS: 45 g/l

BOTTLE SIZE

750 ml

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

Serve over ice. This slightly-sweet sparkling wine is lovely as an aperitif, or enjoyed with light fruit-based desserts.



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
