BACKGROUND

Beni di Batasiolo is the largest family-owned wine producer in Italy's Piedmont region. Since 1978, the winery has grown to encompass over 320 acres of vineyards. The Dogliani family works with the land and allows nature to ensure their wines' quality comes first. Batasiolo's vines prosper across nine beni or estates - in Piedmont. The estates' soil, climate and position among the hills produce a range of noble, elegant wines.

DESCRIPTION

COLOR: Ruby red with violet tinges

NOSE: A bouquet of good intensity and persistence, with fruit and vegetable expressions

TASTE: Dry and well-balanced, with good acidity and very delicate tannins

VINIFICATION

After malolactic fermentation in stainless steel vats for 10-12 days, the juice is refined in Slavonian oak casks for an additional 12 months. The wine then continues to age in stainless steel.

Alcohol: 14.3% TA: 6 pH: 3.4 g/L RS: 1.0g/L

The perfect accompaniment for appetizers and cheese, pasta, first courses, and white and red meat. Serve at 16-18°C (60.8-64.4°F)
