BACKGROUND

Beni di Batasiolo is the largest family-owned wine producer in Italy's Piedmont region. Since 1978, the winery has grown to encompass over 320 acres of vineyards. The Dogliani family works with the land and allows nature to ensure their wines' quality comes first. Batasiolo's vines prosper across nine beni or estates - in Piedmont. The estates' soil, climate and position among the hills produce a range of noble, elegant wines.

DESCRIPTION

COLOR: Deep ruby red

NOSE: An intense and persistent expression with berries, cherries and ripe fruit

TASTE: Full-bodied, tannic and pleasantly cool

VINIFICATION

After an early October harvest, grapes are destemmed & fermented on the skins for 7-10 days in stainless steel vats with periodic pumping-over. The juice is then aged six months in Slavonian oak casks followed by additional time in steel and bottle.

ANALYSIS

Alcohol: 13.7% TA: 5 pH: 3.4 g/L RS: 0.8 g/L

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

Can accompany the entire meal, pairing well with pasta dishes, risotto, red and white meats, and medium-aged cheeses. Serve at 16-18 °C (60.8-64.4 °F)
