BACKGROUND

Beni di Batasiolo is the largest family-owned wine producer in Italy's Piedmont region. Since 1978, the winery has grown to encompass over 320 acres of vineyards. The Dogliani family works with the land and allows nature to ensure their wines' quality comes first. Batasiolo's vines prosper across nine beni - or estates - in Piedmont. The estates' soil, climate and position among the hills produce a range of noble, elegant wines.

PRODUCTION AREA

DESCRIPTION

COLOR: Pale straw yellow with tinges of green

NOSE: Fresh and floral nose with good intensity and persistence

TASTE: Dry and pleasant with lingering notes of almonds, typical of the Cortese grape

VINIFICATION

Cortese grapes from limestone, clay and marl soils are destemmed and soft pressed. The juice is then fermented in stainless steel vats at 16-18 °C (60.8-64.4 °F) with time on the lees.

ANALYSIS

Alcohol: 12.5% TA: 5.6 pH: 3.1 g/L RS: 2.0g/L

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

The perfect accompaniment for appetizers, pasta and risottos, fish, white meat and vegetable-based dishes. Also excellent as an aperitif. Serve at 8 °C (46.4 °F).
